Recycling

Household Recycling

- » **TAG** - Bermuda recycles TAG – tin cans, aluminium cans, glass bottles. See reverse for collection days or bring to the Tynes Bay Public Drop-Off.
- » **E-WASTE** - Cell phones and cell phone batteries can be recycled at service providers. Recycle CPUs, laptops, commercial loads of eWaste by appointment at the MRF.
- » **AIRCONDITIONERS** - household units at the Tynes Bay Public Drop-Off.

Commercial Recycling

- » **AIRCONDITIONERS** - Drop off at the designated area at the Airport Waste Management facility or by appointment at the MRF.

Household Special Waste

Take the following to the designated bins at the Tynes Bay Public Drop-Off:

- » **HOUSEHOLD BATTERIES**: Also recycle at grocers, pharmacies, hardware stores and service stations island-wide.
- » **VEHICLE BATTERIES AND MOTOR OIL**: Also disposable at service stations island-wide.
- » **PAINTS, PESTICIDES AND ANYTHING MARKED WITH A HAZARDOUS LABEL**.

No gasoline or diesel – return these to gas stations.

COMMERCIAL & PUBLIC DROP-OFF FACILITIES

Airport Waste Management Facility *Cahow Way, St. Georges*

Monday to Friday, 7:30 a.m. until 4:00 p.m., Saturday 7:30 a.m. until 12 noon, closed on Sunday. This is an industrial site, absolutely no fishing or riding of cycles. Accepts metal waste, rubble, appliances, tyres, construction and demolition debris only. waste@gov.bm.

Marsh Folly Composting Facility *Marsh Folly Road, Pembroke*

Monday to Friday 7:30 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. Commercial drop-off closed from noon until 1 p.m. Saturday 7:30 a.m. until noon, closed Sunday. Accepts leaf & limb waste from households and businesses, animal carcasses and food waste only. waste@gov.bm.

Material Recovery Facility (MRF) aka the Recycling Centre *Government Quarry, Hamilton Parish*

Monday to Friday 7:30 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. Accepts commercial loads only of TAG, electronics and other recyclables. recycle@gov.bm.

Tynes Bay Public Drop-Off *Palmetto Road, Devonshire*

Open 7:00am until 7:00pm seven days a week. On Public holidays from 9:00am until 12:00pm. Closed on Christmas Day. This is a free waste disposal service available to the drivers of private cars, L and LP vehicles with a maximum of 4 bags of household garbage, accepting all household waste, small metal waste, wooden items, recyclables, electronic waste, waste paint, used motor oil, fluorescent tubes. CFLs and batteries. Call 296-0673 for enquiries.

ZONES FOR COLLECTION

Household Waste

Collected once a week by zone, 1 – 5.

- Zone 1 boundary** = Monday: Dockyard to Lighthouse Road from Middle Road to South Road.
- Zone 2 boundary** = Tuesday: Chapel Road, S Hill and Southcote Road.
- Zone 3 boundary** = Wednesday: T-Street and Kent Avenue, Devonshire Parish. East Broadway. Cavendish Road. Pembroke Parish west of Blackwatch Pass.
- Zone 4 boundary** = Thursday: Devil's Hole Hill and Flatt's.
- Zone 5 boundary** = Friday: Smith's Parish east of Devil's Hole Hill. All of Hamilton and St. George's parishes except the old town.

Recycling & Christmas tree collections are divided into west and east.

West: All areas of Sandys, Southampton, Warwick and Paget parishes and the following areas of Devonshire: Tee Street and Kent Avenue.

East: All areas of St. George's, Hamilton, Smith's, Pembroke and Devonshire parishes – not including Tee Street and Kent Avenue.

WHAT IS COLLECTED?

Christmas Trees Composted to make fertilizer. Remove tinsel, nails and ornaments and place outside on your scheduled day. **Do not use a tree bag.**

WEST END: Collection Day

– Saturday, 17th January 2026.

EAST END: Collection Day

– Saturday, 24th January 2026.

Household Waste


Paper, cardboard, plastic, food waste and other burnable items. To prevent rodents, store food waste in the freezer, and add to bagged garbage on your collection day. Use only plastic bin bags in a lidded bin.

Do not use paper bags and boxes which fall apart creating litter.

Recycling

Collected every other week on Thursday in the west and Friday in the east. TAG (Tin, Aluminium, Glass) recycling. Rinse, place in blue bin, or clear or blue recycling bags and put out for collection every other week per calendar. To report missed collections call email recycle@gov.bm.

GARBAGE: Collected once a week by zone, 1 – 5. To prevent rodents, store bagged garbage in lidded bins at your residence. Move to curb for collection on scheduled day only. Use only lidded bins or sealed plastic bags. Paper bags and boxes fall apart.

NOT COLLECTED!

ANIMAL AND HUMAN FAECES Must not be put in the garbage. Animal faeces may be flushed down the toilet, or dried out, wrapped in newspaper, placed in a plastic bag and disposed of in the bin at Tynes Bay Public Drop-Off, or buried on your property.

ALL HUMAN FAECES MUST BE FLUSHED DOWN THE TOILET.
