The following addendum supersedes information contained in the RFP to the extent referenced. This addendum forms part of the RFP documents and will be subject to all of the conditions set out in the contract conditions.

Questions and Responses

1. Q: Will there be a fee for disposal of the materials arising at the Government facilities?
A: Fees for disposal of materials arising from the Longbird Bridge – Demolition project at Government facilities will **not** be waived. Proponents should consider the cost of disposing of material in their bids.
2. Q: Do the Ministry have any drawings of the turntable construction.
A: All available structural drawings are included in Annex D “Drawings and Reference Documents”. Sheet number S17 of the Delcan drawings (page 24 of the PDF) may be of interest.
3. Q: Do the Ministry have geotechnical information from the local area.
A: Geotechnical information from past projects is included in this addendum. The Ministry accepts no responsibility for the accuracy of the information.
4. Q: Are we to remove the existing navigation lights on the structure to be demolished and relocate them on the Mabey bridges.
A: Existing navigation lights on the structure are to be demolished and disposed of. Relocating is not necessary. The streetlights to the south of the channel are to remain operational.
